

## The Power of Youth

The United States Biosphere Reserve Youth Board (USBN-YB) is a youth-led organization that works in cooperation with the US Biosphere Network Working Group to further the goals of the USBN, the Man and the Biosphere (MAB) Programme, and the United Nations Operational Strategy on Youth.

Youth Boards throughout the world have become a tool to increase youth participation in the visioning and decision-making of biosphere regions.

## **Our Time**

Since January 2024, the team has provided nearly 500 hours of in-kind support towards grant writing, recruitment, professional trainings & workshops, presentations, and network building.

Based on the 2023 value of a volunteer hour at \$33.49 (Independent Sector) our team has committed over \$16,000 in value to the USBN-YB in the last six months.

We have **connected** with the Canadian Commission and **offered support** in the planning and facilitation of **EuroMAB 2026 Youth Conference**.
